

## Royal Thai Air Force Announcement Subject: Not Accepting Gifts and Gratuities in the Course of Official Duties or "No Gift Policy" Fiscal Year 2025

According to Section 21 of the Ministry of Defence Organisation Act B.E.2551 (2008), the Royal Thai Air Force (RTAF) is tasked with the preparation and command of the Air Force to defend the sovereignty of the Kingdom of Thailand in compliance with the authority of the Ministry of Defence. The aforementioned responsibilities fall under the supervision of the RTAF Commander-in-Chief.

In order to strengthen the organizational culture and core operating values, and to support and promote operations aligning with the National Strategy and the National Reform Plan on Preventing and Suppressing Corruption and Misconduct, as well as fulfilling its commitment to become an "Unbeatable Air Force", considering the collective interests of the nation and its people, the RTAF reaffirms its intent by asserting that all commanders and personnel shall not accept any gifts or gratuities before, during, or after the performance of their duties. The acceptance of gifts is deemed an act of corruption and misconduct which can have repercussions in both the present and the future.
